Who is Craig Palmer?

I began my career as a copywriter in Boston and New York City writing television, radio and prints ads for clients that included Pizza Hut, U.S. Navy, AT&T, Campbell's Soup, Burger King and Ponds.

I served as President and CEO of Palmer/Cosmopulos/Palmer, a full-service advertising agency where my clients included Corning, Inc., Serengeti Eyewear, LPGA and the American Cancer Society. I was Founder and President of Pixel Head, a digital marketing agency that specialized in creating websites and interactive CD ROM projects. Pixel Head was honored to be chosen as the first privately-owned company in the country to create and host Websites for Members of the United States Congress.

Originally from Elmira, NY, I was a very active member of my community. I was elected to serve terms on the school board and as

a village trustee. One of my most notable accomplishments was to be elected mayor of Elmira Heights, NY.

Today, I am an accomplished professional artist. I have been painting regularly for the past 30 years. I studied with acclaimed artist Thomas Buechner for 12 years.

I am also an art teacher. I have taught painting classes at the Cedar Arts Center in Corning, NY, the the Arts Center in Bonita Springs, FL and at the Bohemia Collective, Boulder, CO. I spent five years as an adjunct professor at Corning Community College teaching website and graphic design.

I am a graduate of Parsons
School of Design and attended
Syracuse University. My wife

offers, especially paddle boarding,
golf and biking. I have four children,

I love to get out of the studio to paint. With the splendor of every tree, to power of a flowing creek or the curling of a wave, Mother nature offers us an endless bounty of subject matter. Over the past 20 years, I've spent countless hours attempting to capture these fleeting moments on canvas.

DAVIS PHINNEY FOUNDATION PROJECT

I'm originally from upstate NY, and several friends from my tiny hometown curiously developed Parkinson's disease at far too young an age. Shortly after I moved to Boulder, one of these friends called to ask if she could stay with us while she was working on a project with a local Parkinson's non-profit called Davis Phinney Foundation for Parkinson's. During her visit, she introduced me to the founders Davis and Colleen Phinney, and other folks who were running the organization.

I was deeply inspired by their work to improve the quality of life for people with Parkinson's, and wanted to offer my support through my love of painting. Together, we created a plan for painting portraits of 30 Davis Phinney ambassadors located around the country. Our strategy was to donate the paintings and create a fundraising event, which would eventually put the portraits in the hands of the ambassadors. I was about mid-way through the process when COVID hit, and the fundraising event had to be postponed.

I am so honored to be able to capture the spirit of these courageous ambassadors, many of which suffer from PD themselves, who work tirelessly to support the DP foundation.

My transformation from realism to abstraction.

The past year has had a profound impact on all of us. For me, 2020 was life altering as I discovered a new (for me!) form of artistic expression - abstract painting.

Having spent the past 30 years as a realist, my transformation to abstraction surprised many of my friends, family and collectors. It surprised everyone, but me.

Over the years, I've attempted to create abstract paintings many times with no success. Abstract painting was pure torture. Then, one day I had an epiphany. - use the same priciples of painting (shape, color, value, edges, line, texture, composition) that I use to a portrait or landscape to paint an abstract. From that moment on, something clicked. Inspired by my time living in the Rocky Mountains, an entirely new style emerged from my paintbrush.

I will always be a realistic artist, but I know that my artistic journey is going to help me create exciting new work. I am very busy experimenting with new techniques and materials that I can use to aid in my transformation.
